Defendant. Based on the parties' Stipulated Motion to Remand (Doc. 8), IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Commissioner's decision in regard to Plaintiffs applications for disability benefits be REVERSED AND REMANDED to the Commissioner of Social Security for a new hearing before an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) and a new decision in regard to Plaintiffs applications for disability benefits. On remand, the ALJ will take any necessary action to complete the administrative record, offer Plaintiff a new hearing, re-evaluate the medical evidence of record, re-evaluate Plaintiffs RFC, continue through the sequential evaluation process, and issue a new decision.
