ORDER

Before the Court is Defendant Lincoln National Life Insurance Company's motion for the admission of attorney Hanna E. Eickmeier of Bradley Arant Boult Cummings LLP, pro hac vice, in the above-captioned matter. (Doc. 18.) It appears that Randall J. Colbert of Garlington, Lohn & Robinson, PLLP, will serve as local counsel in this matter. (Id. at 2.) Ms. Eickmeier's application (Doc. 18 -1) complies with this Court's Local Rules governing the admission of counsel pro hac vice. L.R. 83.1(d).

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the motion (Doc. 18) is GRANTED on the condition that Ms. Eickmeier does her own work. This means that she must: (1) do her own writing; (2) sign her own pleadings, motions, and briefs; and (3) appear and participate personally. Ms. Eickmeier shall take steps to register in the Court's electronic filing system (CM -ECF). IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order is subject to withdrawal unless Ms. Eickmeier files a separate pleading acknowledging her admission under the terms set forth above within fifteen (15) days of this Order.
