On order of the Court, the application for leave to appeal is considered, and it is GRANTED, limited to the issue whether the defendant was denied due process because of the statutorily-authorized Appeal Board composition in this case which included a member "representative of the general public" and a member "representative of employee interest" but no member "representative of employer interest."

The clerk is directed to place this case on the October, 1987 session calendar. Briefs and appendixes are to be filed in conformity with MCR 7.309 except that the brief and appendix of the appellant is to be filed no later than August 11, 1987, and the brief and appendix, if necessary, of appellee is to be filed no later than 28 days after the date of filing by the appellant. The parties may file typewritten briefs and xerographic appendixes to be followed by printed briefs and appendixes as soon as possible.
