REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

The Court previously screened, dismissed without prejudice, and ordered Plaintiff to file an amended complaint (if he so chose). See ECF No. 6. The Court later gave Plaintiff until February 5, 2024 to amend his complaint. ECF No. 10 at 3. The Court advised Plaintiff that if he did not file an amended complaint by this date, the Court may recommend that his case be dismissed. ECF No. 6 at 3. Since this order, Plaintiff has not filed anything in his case. Accordingly, he appears to have abandoned his case. IT IS prejudice and that this case closed.
