This matter is before the Court on the January 11, 2017 Report and Becky R. Thorson. (Dkt. 7.) The R&R recommends dismissing without prejudice Plaintiff Paul Canini, complaint for failure to prosecute. No objections to the R&R have been filed. In the absence of timely objections, this Court reviews an R&R for clear error. See Fed. R. Civ. the court need only satisfy itself that there is no clear error on the face of the record in order to accept *Grinder v. Gammon*, 73 F.3d 793, 795 (8th Cir. 1996). Having reviewed the R&R, the Court finds no clear error.

ORDER Based on the R&R and all of the files, records and proceedings herein, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The January 11, 2017 R&R, (Dkt. 7), is ADOPTED;

2 2. Plaintiff Paul Canini, , (Dkt. 1), is DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE for failure to prosecute, pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b).
