This matter is before the Court on the January 11, 2017 Report and Becky R. Thorson. (Dkt. 7.) The R&R recommends dismissing without prejudice Plaintiff Paul Canini, complaint for failure to prosecute. No objections to the R&R have been filed. In the absence of timely objections, this Court reviews an R&R for clear error. See Fed. R. Civ. the court need only satisfy itself that there is no clear error on the face of the record in order to accept Grinder v. Gammon, 73 F.3d 793, 795 (8th Cir. 1996). Having reviewed the R&R, the Court finds no clear error.

- 1. The January 11, 2017 R&R, (Dkt. 7), is ADOPTED;
