ORDER

Pending before this Court is the Unopposed Motion for Stay of Order Compelling Disclosure of Information and Documents filed by relators, Michael Rockafellow and MTBC, Ltd. By their motion, relators seek an order staying the disclosure and production of discovery in trial court cause number 2011-559,299 in the 237th District Court of Lubbock County, Texas, the Honorable Les Hatch, presiding. The trial court signed an order on August 7, 2012, in which it granted in part and denied in part real party in interest SalonQuest, L.L.C.'s motion to compel discovery. Relators have filed a petition for writ of mandamus in which they seek this Court's review of the trial court's order. As authorized by the Texas Rules of Appellate Procedure, we grant relators' motion and issue this order staying the enforcement of the trial court's August 7, 2012 order on SalonQuest's motion to compel disclosure in trial court cause number 2011- 559,299 pending this Court's disposition of relators' petition for writ of mandamus.
